Dear Sister,

We have received many, many applications for teaching in our Program, but we have been allotted only 2.5 positions. In order to involve more women in the Program we had to offer less than full time positions. This prevented many women ^{who needed full professor} from being accepted. ~~they needed a full time position.~~ We are beginning to consider student-taught extensions of faculty classes. With the ^{current financial crisis} ~~scarcity of~~ in California education and the chauvinism we ^{have} encounter ^{ed} here, we have had little success in our struggle for obtaining more positions. Hopefully, out of further struggles more Women's Studies Programs can be established and more positions will then then be open for you to teach in. Thank you for applying.
