Dear John:

In the September issue of the CWSS Newsletter, the words "political" and "establishment" are used in the article on the student chapter. Let me briefly explain what is meant by those words. "Political" is meant to indicate the thrust towards social change; i.e., the re-arranging of priorities and relationships in order to provide for the needs of those groups who have not had sufficiently strong input into the social order. (an example of the above would be providing 24 hour child care for women.)
