

Form letter to send to applicants April 1 1970 (?)

Dear Sister,

We have received many, many applications for teaching in our Program, but we have been allotted only 2.5 positions. In order to involve more women in the Program we had to offer less than full time positions. This prevented many women ^{who needed} ~~from being accepted as~~ ~~they needed~~ ^{for} full time positions ^{from being accepted.} We are beginning to consider student taught extensions of faculty classes. With the ^{current} ~~squeeze on~~ ^{have} in California education and the chauvinism we encounter ^{here} we have had little success in our struggle for obtaining more positions. Hopefully, out of further struggles more Women's Studies Programs can be established and more positions will then then be open for you to teach in. Thank you for applying.
