The Honorable the Board of Trustees
of the State Normal School of San Diego.

Gentlemen:-

As directed by your Executive Committee, I communicated with the National Bank of Commerce informing it that the Board had appointed the California State Bank as the Attorney in Fact of this Board at Sacramento for the purpose of collecting the Treasurer's warrants for sums of money due the Normal School, and asked it if, under these changed conditions, it wished to retain the Normal School account. Mr. Wangenheim, President of the bank, informed me that the old charges for over-draft had been passed to "Profit and Loss," and that he would be glad ^{to have the bank} continue as the depository of the school without making any charges whatsoever, for collecting the warrants. According to your directions, I, therefore, notified the bank that the Board would continue to make it the depository of the Normal School funds.
