Re: Personnel Committee Criteria for Hiring and Rehiring from the Ad Hoc Personnel
Comm., of the Women's Studies Board

Thursday evening, March 11, a sheet entitled Personnel Committee Criteria for Hiring and Rehiring was distributed at the Academic Board Meeting of the Women's Studies Program.

I ACCUSE THIS COMMITTEE OF QUICKLY PREPARING SUCH A CRITERIA LIST AFTER THEY HAD MADE THEIR RECOMMENDATIONS AND, FURTHERMORE, OF CREATING A LIST WHICH HAS ONLY ONE PURPOSE: TO CARRY OUT THE POLITICAL REPRISAL OF NOT REHIRING ME.

1. The Criteria Sheet was first seen in any form last Thursday, March 11, a full week after the Ad Hoc Personnel Comm. had made its recommendations.
2. The Criteria Sheet was, in fact, finished the week of March 11, and was not, therefore, some list of guiding principles of several weeks duration - as some Committee members claimed. In fact, according to a former Board member, she herself had suggested Point # 5 to the Ad Hoc Personnel Comm. the day before the Board met.
3. The Minutes of March 11, 1971, present "Reasons that Joyce is not suggested to be rehired by the Personnel Comm." These "reasons" are not any of them in any shape, form, or size the criteria on the Criteria Sheet. I have elsewhere referred to these reasons as "technical gibberish" to cover up the fact of political reprisal.

I REPEAT: THE CRITERIA ON THE CRITERIA SHEET HAVE BEEN TAILOR MADE FOR ME * BECAUSE OF MY AFFILIATION WITH CWSS.
