Bids were received as follows:

Kindler Plumbing Company - - - - -	\$1,196.00

Toms & Blair - - - - -	1,375.00

The bid of the Kindler Plumbing Company, being the lowest and best, the contract was informally awarded to said company.

During the meeting, President Ward communicated with Trustee Akerman, who concurred in the action above mentioned. President Black afterward met Mr. Akerman in his office, and exhibited the bids and specifications to Mr. Akerman, who advised that the Kindler Plumbing Company be notified to go on with the work.
