At a meeting of your Executive Committee held this day in the office of Hon. M. L. Ward in the Granger Block, the following members were present: Trustees M. L. Ward, J. W. Stearns, and J. S. Akerman.

I have the honor to report that E. S. Martin met me at the Normal School building on Saturday, August 31st. I showed him over the building, and explained to him your views, and stated the salary attached to the position.
