Dear Dean Carrier:

We (on the Women's Studies Board) ~~xxx~~ understand that the College of Arts and Letters might receive new faculty allocations due to exceptionally high FTE in some departments. Thus we would bring to your attention that Women's Studies has the third highest FTE in the College even though two of our ten courses in the Spring semester were not offered during registration and filled up only after the official lists were made up. Given that we are the first women's studies program in the country, that many of us have traveled and publicized this program at our own expense (Modern Language Association Convention, Fresno colloquium on women, Santa Cruz Conference on Women's Studies, and national conference on women's studies in New York, May 29-31), that we have a fine new faculty coming for the program next year, we feel that Women's Studies is exceptionally deserving of faculty allocations more commensurate with the demands of the students at San Diego State College.
