Upon the motion of Trustee Akerman, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

Whereas the Faculty of this Normal School have certified that Edna Clare Blosser, Mary Hazel Grigsby, and Clayton James Wight have worthily completed the course of study and training prescribed for the State Normal Schools of California and have recommended them for graduation in accordance with the provisions of Section 1503 of the Political Code:

Resolved, That the aforesaid students be, and they hereby are, graduated from the State Normal School of San Diego, and the President of this Board and the President of the school are hereby directed and authorized to sign and deliver to said students diplomas certifying to the fact that they have graduated from the State Normal School of San Diego.

Trustee Akerman reported that he had examined the gutter on the roof on the north side of the building, and found that it will be necessary to re-enforce the gutter by placing a piece of tin along the inside of the gutter at a cost of Fifty Dollars. Mr Akerman reported that he had ordered the work done at that price.

There being no further business before the committee, the meeting was adjourned.
