My Dear Black :-

Referring to your letter of inquiry of May 11, allow me to say first that we pay our librarian, Miss Ruth Royce, a salary of \$1550 per year.

Second, we have something over 12,000 volumes in our library besides a large number of pamphlets.

Third, All of our students use the library, and in our new building we expect to have accommodations for 300 sittings in our library.

Fourth, At present the library is opened at 8 A. M. and closed about five. Saturdays it is opened at 9 and closed at noon.

I am not sure just what arrangements we shall make when we get into our new building.

We have a teacher who assists in the library at certain times when Miss Royce is away or is crowded with work.
