Curtis, Irma Heilbron, Margaret Alice Kilty, Lela Estella marks, and Maggie Myrle Schlatter have worthily completed the course of study and training prescribed for the State Normal Schools of California, and have recommended them for graduation in accordance with the provisions of Section 1503 of the Political Code:

Resolved, That the aforesaid students be, and they hereby are graduated from the State Normal School of San Diego, and the President of this Board and the President of the school are hereby directed and authorized to sign and deliver to said students diplomas certifying to the fact that they have been graduated from the State Normal School of San Diego.
