

The Healing Touch

Mark 5: 22-23

"A ruler from the synagogue, named Jairus, came to that place. Jairus saw Jesus and knelt before him. The ruler begged Jesus saying, 'again and again, "My daughter is dying. Please come and put your hands on her. Then she will be healed and will live."'

7 kinds of how many different kinds of touch there are. There is touch that's not so nice. Such as hitting, slapping, pinching or poking. Why do people hit and pinch and poke? Let kids respond.

- Then there's playful touch like tickling, tickle a child. Then is messing up hair. Mess up hair.

- Then there's loving touch. Sometimes when someone is sad and you don't know what to say, you might just put your hand on that person's arm. Put hand on arm. That helps the person feel better.

- But if you really loves someone, what would you do? Let kids respond. That's a hug or a kiss.

We don't need words to always let people know how people feel.

About them. Teachers are ways of talking with words. (Hand
left again) The dad knew that if Jesus would touch the little girl, she
would be healed. And you know what? The dad was right.

We may not be able to ~~read~~ touch our touch, but we can make people
feel better by giving them a kiss or hug or pat on the back. When we use
touch like Jesus did, people will know how much we care for them.

When you get back to your seat give someone a big hug.

Let them know with your hug that you love them.
