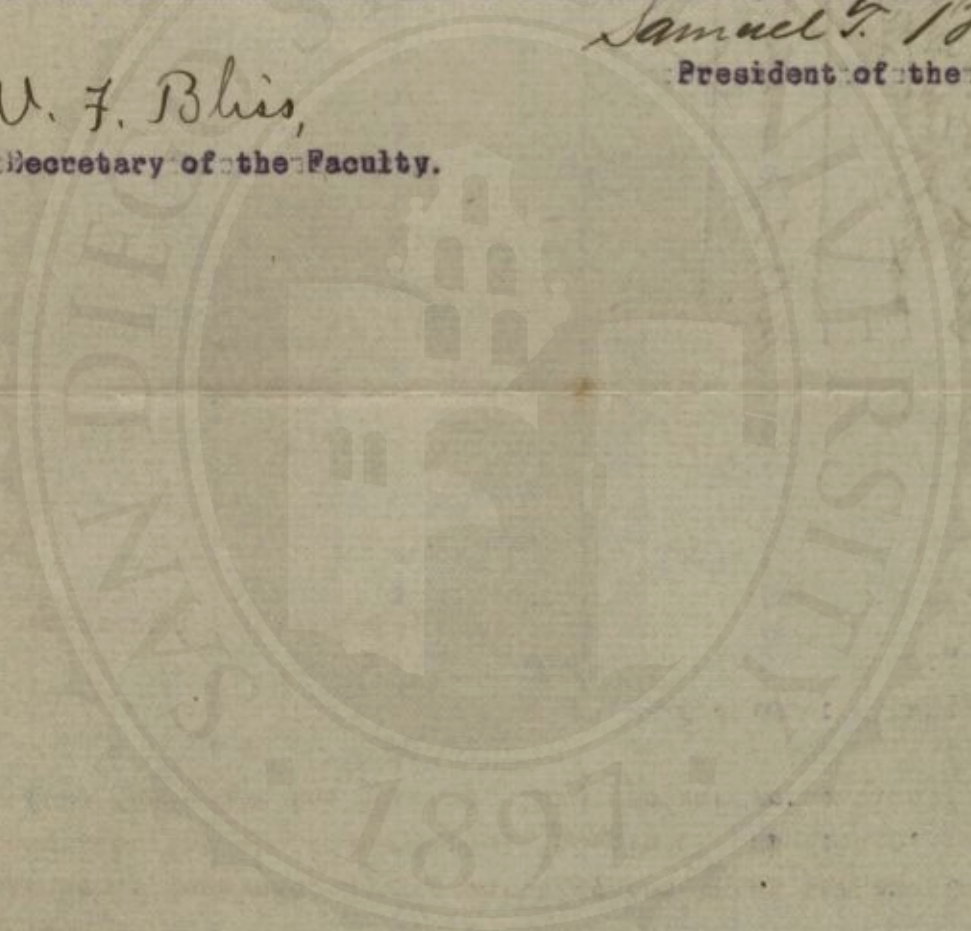
Gentlemen:

At a meeting of the Faculty of the State Normal School of San Diego held in the office of the school October 2nd, 1902, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

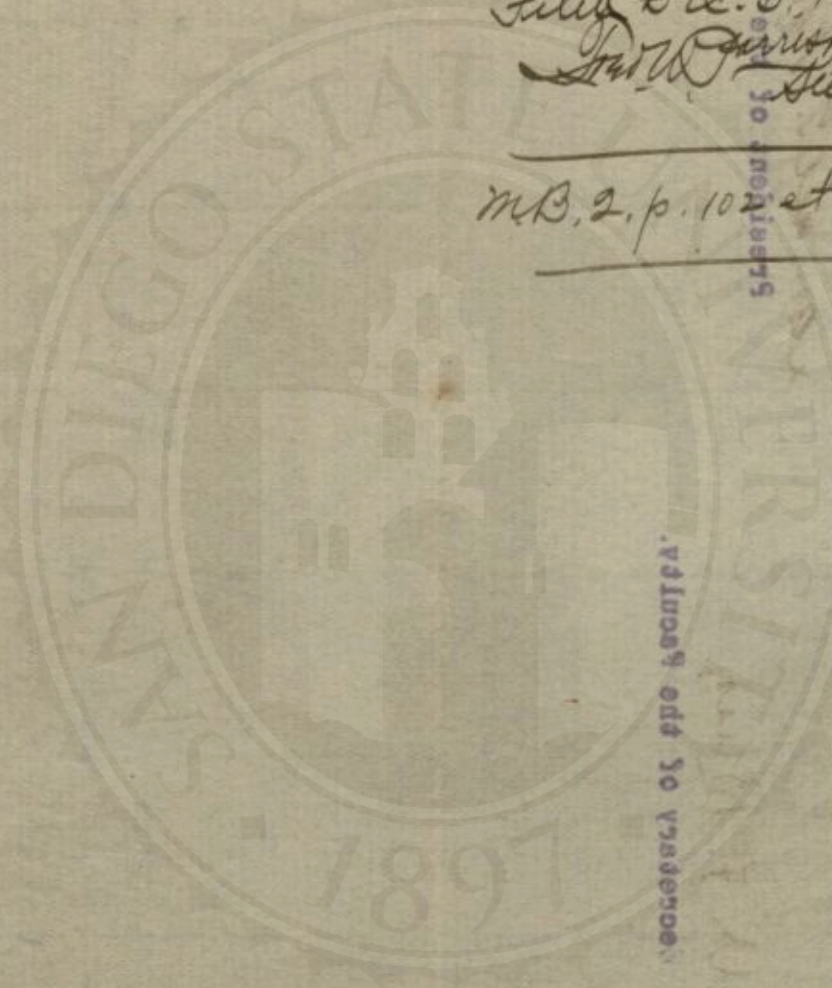
